

Rental assistance programs are here to help

The Arizona Department of Housing is offering rental assistance for people directly impacted by COVID-19 such as a loss of wages, fewer hours at work, childcare issues and school closures. Apply online or call the Pima County hotline at (520) 724 - 2667 for assistance.

Pima County Community Services offers discount programs and financial assistance for utility, rent or mortgage payment. All programs are based on income eligibility and the availability of funds.

Applicants must have a state-issued picture I.D., proof of U.S. citizenship or permanent legal residence, social security cards for all household members, birth certificates for children 17 and under, proof of all household income for the past 30 days, rental late notice or lease, current mortgage statement, utility bills and documents regarding the crisis impacting the ability to pay for rent.

Financial Assistance and Discount Program

ALL financial assistance programs are based on income eligibility and the availability of funds

Required documents

These documents are required for all types of assistance applications. Once you have all the documents listed here, you may call the numbers below to request an appointment.

- Applicant's state-issued picture I.D.
- Applicant's proof of U.S. Citizenship or Permanent Legal Residence (birth certificate, naturalization papers, permanent resident card, U. S. passport)
- Social security cards for all household members
- Birth certificates for children 17 and under

- Proof of all household income for the past 30 days (pay stubs, current award letters, etc.)
 - Rental eviction/late notice and/or lease
 - Current mortgage statement/coupon
 - Current utility bills (electric, gas, water) – no cable and/or telephone bills
 - Supporting documentation regarding the crisis that caused you to get behind in your rent/mortgage.
- Additional information may be required at the time of appointment.

Utility/Rent/Mortgage Assistance *(limited assistance available)*

Financial assistance may be available for eviction prevention, mortgage payment, move-in, utility, utility deposit, and utility repair/replacement assistance, as well as special needs such as dental, vision, and car repairs. Callers will be screened for potential eligibility; an appointment may be scheduled based on available funds and/or appointments.

Documentos requeridos

Estos documentos son requeridos para todas las solicitudes de asistencia. Ya que tenga los siguientes documentos, llame a los números de abajo para pedir una cita.

- Identificación del solicitante otorgada por el estado con foto
- Comprobante de Ciudadanía o Estatus Permanente del solicitante
- Comprobante de residencia (acta de nacimiento, documentos de naturalización, tarjeta de residente permanente, pasaporte Americano)
- Tarjetas de seguro social de todos los miembros de la familia

- Actas de nacimiento para niños menores de 17 años
- Comprobante de todos los ingresos del hogar de los últimos 30 días (talones de cheque, cartas de adjudicación, etc.)
- Evicción de alquiler/aviso de retraso y/o arrendamiento
- Factura de hipoteca actual/cupón
- Factura de servicios públicos (electricidad, gas, agua) – no cable y/o facturas de teléfono
- Documentos que apoyen el motivo por el que se atrasó en su hipoteca/renta

Información adicional le puede ser requerida durante la cita.

Asistencia con Servicios Públicos/Renta/Hipoteca

(asistencia limitada)

Asistencia financiera puede estar disponible para prevenir su desalojamiento, pago de hipoteca, mudanza, servicios públicos, depósito para servicios públicos y asistencia con la reparación de servicios públicos, además de necesidades especiales como cuidado dental y de la vista, y reparaciones de auto. Los solicitantes serán evaluados para posible elegibilidad; se fijará una cita según la disponibilidad de fondos y/o citas.
